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These are the collected essays and other contributions to Asian studies which Professor Lattimore has written over several decades. He has divided the book into six sections – the Inner Asian Frontier, Sinkiang, Mongolia, Manchuria, and China, national minorities, and social history. Professor Lattimore is one of the few Westerners who speaks Chinese, Mongolian and Russian and one of the very few, since Sir Aurel Stein's great explorations, who have travelled extensively through the desert edges and mountain ranges of the Chinese Frontier. The central aspect of his study has been his developing concept of pastoral nomadism.



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
