Each chapter describes vividly the landscape of the country from end to end, introduces the people who inhabit the land, and gives their consecutive history from earliest to modern times.


The economy is discussed, with latest facts and figures. There are sections on public finance, planning, agriculture, industry, transport, trade, education and health.




