The economy is discussed, with latest facts and figures. There are sections on public finance, planning, agriculture, industry, transport, trade, education and health.

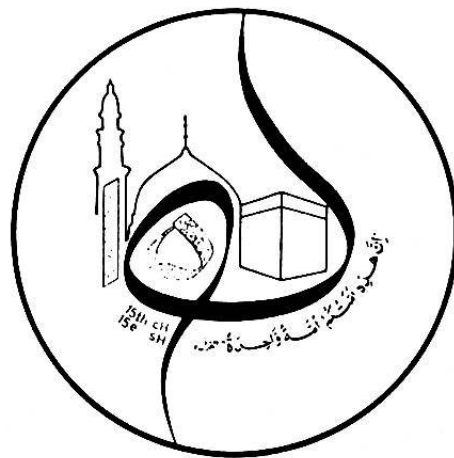
The great success story of the resurgence of Islam in Europe and America is presented in two separate chapters.

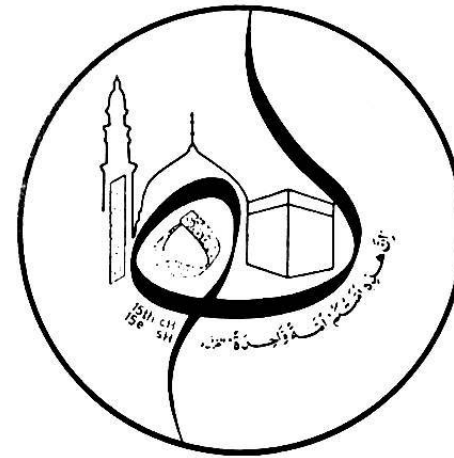

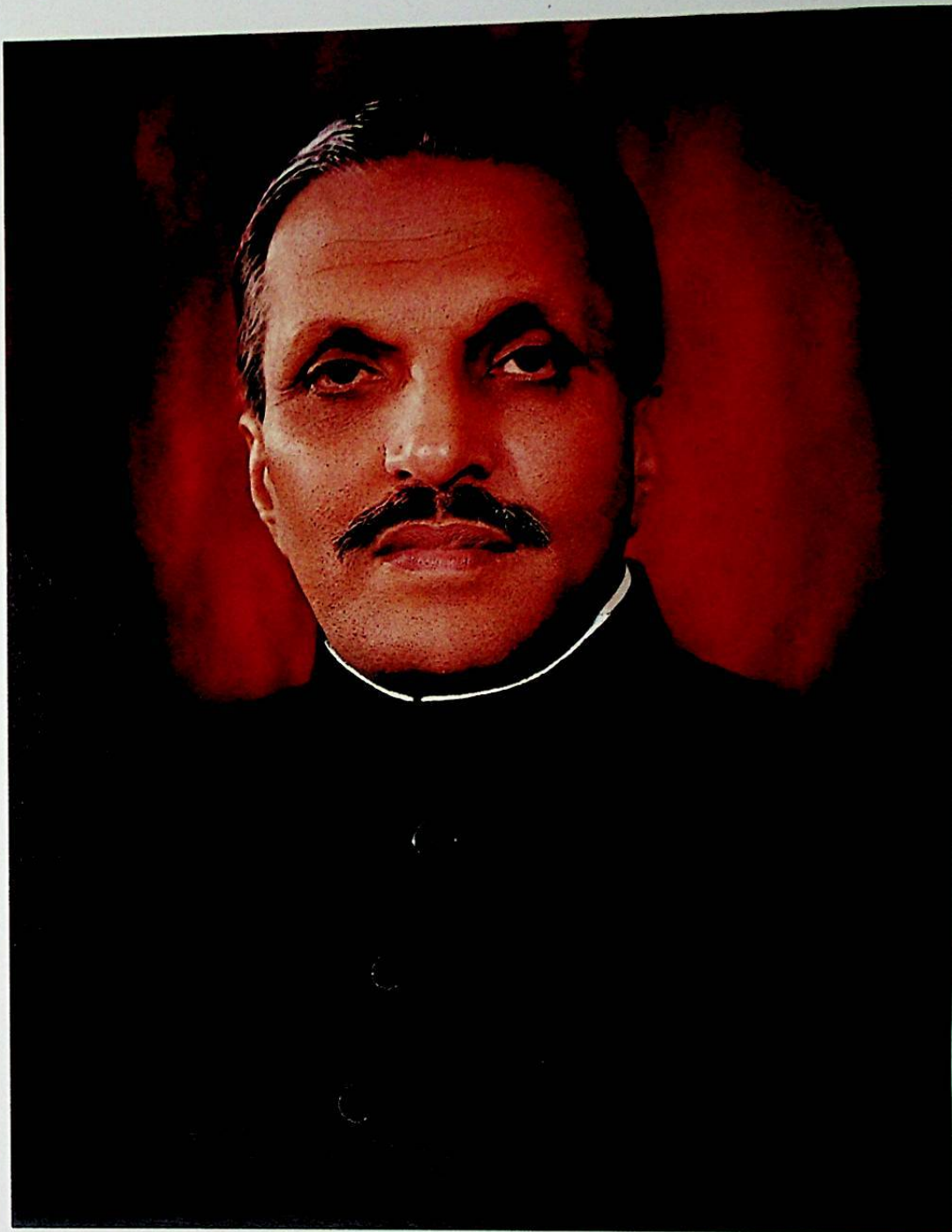
