BASIC GOVERNMENT SYSTEM

Article 1

The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is an Arab and Islamic sovereign state, its religion is Islam, and its constitution the Holy Quran and the Prophet, Sunnah, Its language is Arabic and Capital Riyadh.

SHOURA COUNCIL SYSTEM BASED ON THE FOLLOWING VERSES

"It is part of the Mercy of God that thou dost deal gently with them". Wert thou severe or harsh-hearted. They would have broken away from about thee; so pass over (Their faults), and ask for God's forgiveness for them; and consult them in affairs (of moment). Then when thou hast taken a decision, put thy trust in God. For God loves those who put their trust (in Him). "Those who hearken to their Lord, and establish regular prayer; who (conduct) their affairs by mutual consultation who spend out of what we bestow on them for Sustenance"

PROVINCIAL SYSTEM Article 1

This system aims at upgrading the levels of the administrative work and development in all parts of the Kingdom. It also aims at the preservation of security and order, the rights of the citizen's and their freedom in the framework of the Islamic Shoura.

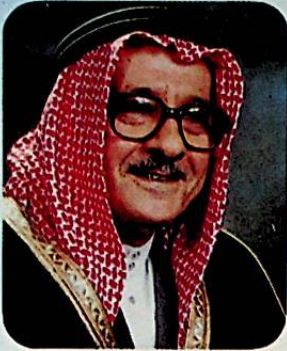
